## Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 18.17 of the Clerical Agreement, to place Mr. Troy Cook, Meter Reader, Concord, into a Utility Clerk position in Concord, East Bay Region.

Mr. Cook sustained an industrial injury to his left knee on June 4, 1984. He has subsequently been precluded from prolonged walking, repetitive squatting, kneeling and climbing ladders or stairs.

On August 8, 1985, Mr. Cook was placed into the Utility Clerk position on a temporary basis while on the Rehabilitation Payroll.

Mr. Cook's date of employment is April 9, 1984 and we, therefore, propose to place him at the wage rate of \$433.35 per week, pursuant to Subsection 7.10(b)(2) of the Clerical Agreement. Also, this placement will be recorded as neither an unrestricted appointment nor a transfer.

It is our understanding that this proposal has been reviewed with Mr. Art Murray, Union Business Representative.
