Gentlemen:

Mr. Randall L. Meahan, a Lineman in Richmond District of East Bay Region, is permanently precluded from performing the duties of a Lineman due to a non-industrial heart condition. However, Mr. Meahan has been medically cleared to perform the duties of an Inspector.

Accordingly, and in an effort to put Mr. Meahan's skills and experience to optimal use, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Meahan into a vacant Inspector position in Richmond District of East Bay Region.

Mr. Meahan's employment date is November 6, 1978. Pursuant to Subsection 112.10 (c)(2) of the Physical Agreement, Mr. Meahan's rate of pay will be \$615.20 per week.

The matter has been discussed with Mr. Art Murray, Union Business Representative.
