Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement and Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to change the regular work hours of the operating clerical and Gas T&D employees in the Roseville Service Center from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. This proposal is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. No overtime will result when changing from the current hours of work to the new work hours.
- 2. The regular lunch period for the new work hours will be from 11:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon. This regular lunch period may be advanced or delayed one hour or less in accordance with Section 202.4.
- 3. Clerical and Gas T&D employees reassigned from another headquarters to the Roseville Service Center on either a regular or temporary basis shall work the new hours schedule without overtime pay for the work hours change.

The Roseville Service Center is very small, and overcrowding is a continuing problem. Only one room is available for use as a meeting and ready room. It is not large enough to adequately accommodate use by the T&D and service employees at the same time, which frequently results in work disruptions. This change should, therefore, result in enhanced operational efficiency.
