On December 4, 1984, Company and Union agreed to an update of Job Definitions and Lines of Progression for Exhibit VI-A, Materials Distribution and Division Materials Departments, including Pipeline Operations (reference Letter Agreement 84-125-PGE.)

Through an oversight, the (0530) Filterman and (1934) Painter Lines of Progression did not list as same or higher the unassigned classifications for the (2626) Certified Welder and (2637) Traveling Certified Welder classifications.
