Gentlemen:

Company proposes to amend Section 600.4, Exhibit VI-C, Pipe Line Operations Department Job Definitions and Lines of Progression for the (2415) Gas Transmission Technician per the attachment.

This change is necessary due to the fact that the Federal Communications Commission is no longer testing and issuing licenses for the maintenance and operation of land mobile radios. As we have no training program to teach these skills, Company must rely upon the old license or the new certification program to obtain qualified candidates.

Company is proposing the certification program administered by the National Association of Business and Educational Radio (NABER), however, other certifying agents may also meet the Company's approval to certify technicians.

Company proposes to add the Unassigned Gas Control Mechanic (1404) as next lower, same or higher, everywhere the Gas Control Mechanic appears in the Lines of Progression.

TECHNICAL MAINTENANCE

2415 Gas Transmission Technician

An employee who possesses the qualifications and performs the duties of a Gas Control Mechanic and in addition installs, tests, adjusts, operates, and maintains gas supervisory, remote control, and communication systems, including but not limited to electronic controllers, computers, and their related components, carrier, microwave, and radio equipment. He may be required to act as a leadman supervising the work of other employees in lower classifications engaged in this work. He must have a Radio Telephone Operator's License or a Company-approved certification. His background of training, education, and experience must be such as to qualify him to perform these duties with skill and efficiency.
