The updated Job Definitions and Lines of Progression for Exhibit VI, Division Gas Transmission and Distribution Department, revised August 19, 1985, moved the Field Clerk classification from a "next lower" to "same or higher" classification designation in the Truck Driver line of progression. Inasmuch as the Heavy Truck Driver can bid to Field Clerk and Field Clerk can bid to an Equipment Operator, which is higher in the line of progression to the Heavy Truck Driver, Company proposes to add the (0240) Field Clerk - Gas to the "next lower" classifications in the Heavy Truck Driver line of progression.
