Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Section 202.16 of the Physical Agreement and Letter Agreement No. 86-155-PGE, to establish a trial ten-hour, four-day workweek schedule for the Roseville Gas Service Department in Drum Division. We propose to make this trial effective November 12, 1987 through May 10, 1988.

This schedule will apply to all bargaining unit personnel in this department with the exception of one Service Operator in Roseville who will retain his normal five-day workweek with new regular work hours of 0630-1530.

With the exception of one Serviceman in Roseville, the regular work hours under the ten-hour, four-day workweek will be 0700-1730 with personnel assigned as follows:

Roseville Gas Service

Three Servicemen assigned Monday - Thursday Four Servicemen assigned Tuesday - Friday Four Servicemen assigned Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday (Wednesday off) One Serviceman assigned Wednesday - Saturday Two Reserve Gas Servicemen assigned Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday (Wednesday off)

<u>NOTE</u>: Exception (Roseville)

One Serviceman assigned Wednesday - Saturday with regular work hours of 1100 - 2100

The trial will follow the provisions of the generic ten-hour, four-day workweek schedule outlined in Letter Agreement No. 86-155 PGE, with the following three exceptions:

Meals and Rest Periods (Replaces "Meals" paragraph of Letter Agreement No. 86-155-PGE.) Lunch period will normally be five hours after start time. However, the regular lunch period may be advanced or delayed up to one-half hour for any of the reasons listed in Section 202.4 of the Agreement.

Two rest periods not to exceed 15 minutes each will be permitted; one rest period is to be taken in the middle part of the first half of the workday, and one rest period is to be taken in the middle part of the second half of the workday. Lunch periods and rest periods cannot be accumulated or combined and taken together.

<u>Holidays</u> (Replaces "Holidays" paragraph of Letter Agreement No. 86-155-PGE.) Ten hours' pay will be paid for holidays. Employees regularly scheduled to work on holidays will only work eight hours and receive ten hours' holiday pay (straight time) and eight hours' pay at one-and-one-half times the straight rate of pay. The provisions of Section 103.6 shall apply to holidays on an employee's non-workday (utilizing the ten-hour credit as applied in Item No. 2, Vacation, of the generic agreement).

<u>Cancellation Clause</u> (Replaces "Cancellation Clause" paragraph of Letter Agreement No. 86-155-PGE.) This agreement may be cancelled 30 days after written notice of such cancellation by either party. In the event of cancellation, all employees would return to their regular eight-hour shifts in effect on May 1, 1987.
