Gentlemen:

The following is a proposal to cancel Letter Agreement 86-141-PGE which was a five-month trial of a "ten-hour, four-day" workweek for all classifications except Operator Mechanic at McDonald Island Underground Storage Facility and establish a new letter of agreement as follows:

This letter agreement is in accordance with generic Letter Agreement 86-141-PGE with the following exceptions:

- Extend the "ten-hour, four-day" workweek for all classifications except Operator Mechanic at McDonald Island Underground Storage, Pipe Line Operations, through December 31, 1987.
- Change the work hours from 0700 to 1730 to 0600 to 1630.
- Return James Vosburg, Transmission Mechanic to the traditional eight-hour, five-day workweek.

These proposals were discussed and agreed upon in a joint Union-Company Committee on April 14, 1987 which was convened to review the progress and effectiveness of the "ten-hour, four-day" workweek.
