The Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement to extend the temporary placement of Mr. Ed Twedt as a Measurement and Control Mechanic T/A in Sacramento Division for an additional six months.

Mr. Twedt was temporarily placed into this position in November, 1987 pursuant to Letter Agreement 87-221 (copy attached) in hopes that future regular placement would be possible via attrition. Regular placement has not been possible to date; however, attrition in the department is anticipated to occur in June.

It is our understanding that this proposal has been discussed with Mr. Wayne Greer, Union Business Representative.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes the temporary placement of Mr. Ed Twedt as a Measurement and Control Mechanic T/A in Sacramento Division.

On January 22, 1986, Mr. Twedt was taken to Kaiser Emergency for a possible heart attack. Since this time, Mr. Twedt has been permanently precluded from returning to his supervisory position (Gas Transmission and Regulation Supervisor). Mr. Twedt will be acting as a temporary additional Measurement and Control Mechanic in hopes that future regular placement in this position will come about in the near future via attrition. Company proposes to temporarily place Mr. Twedt in this position for a period not to exceed six months.
