Gentlemen:

In order to better serve the telecommunication needs of the Drum area, the Company decided in February, 1987 to separate the Regional Electric Telecommunications group, consisting of five Telecommunications Technicians, into a Division and Hydro jurisdiction. Three Telecommunications Technicians would serve the Division and two Hydro Telecommunications Technicians would serve the Hydro jurisdiction.

At the time of the implementation of this decision, two Hydro Telecommunications Technicians, Robert L. Chunn and Ken A. Bradley, volunteered to accept the position in Auburn, Drum Division, with the understanding that they would have preferential bidding rights to return to Hydro should a vacancy occur. However, this understanding was never formalized.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, the Company proposes to formalize the commitment made to these employees by providing them Subsection 206.9(a) rights to Telecommunications Technician, Hydro Generation, Auburn. This Agreement has been reviewed with Union Business Representative, Ed Fortier.
