Gentlemen:

Company proposes to establish the classification of Utility Pressure Operator at the San Joaquin Gas Load Center in Fresno, with the following job definition:

Utility Pressure Operator - Fresno

An employee who is an Emergency Relief Pressure Operator and, in addition, may be assigned clerical duties including the checking of charts and the calculation of volumes for all types of gas measurement. May be assigned to work in the group reporting to the Regulation and Transmission Foreman, performing meter and regulator work of a routine nature such as zeroing gauges, checking temperature and pressure readings for accuracy. May work alone in performing routine chart changes, cleaning and maintenance in connection with the Load Center and transmission station facilities.

It is further proposed that the employee in this classification will accrue classification seniority as a Pressure Operator and receive the same wage rate of the Pressure Operator classification at Fresno.
