Gentlemen:

During the last year the duties of the First Operator at Chico Substation have been increased by the addition of a number of electric and water alarms and by addition of several unattended substations to the jurisdiction of the First Operators. As a result of these changes the duties of this classification are now comparable to those of First Operators at Marysville Substation and Wilson Substation, both of which are in Schedule I.

Company, therefore, proposes to change the First Operator classification, Chico Substation, from Schedule II with a wage rate of \$131.40 per week to Schedule I with a wage rate of \$135.15 per week.

Company further proposes to reclassify the incumbent First Operators at Chico Substation from Schedule II to Schedule I on the date agreement is reached on this proposal.
