Gentlemen:

Mr. A. G. Jonas is currently classified as a Utilityman in the Hydro Generation Department at Tiger Creek, with a wage rate of \$116.60 per week.

The duties of this classification have been Station Attendant - West Point Power House - 35%; patrol, repair and maintain distribution lines and telephone equipment - 55%; check hydrographic gauging stations - 5%; relieve Quartermaster - 5%.

The duties of this classification have changed during the past year to the point where Company believes that the classification of Utility Roving Operator is appropriate. Company, therefore, proposes to establish the classification of Utility Roving Operator with the following job definition:

Utility Roving Operator - Tiger Creek

An employee who performs the duties of a Roving Operator, and in addition is in charge of materials and supplies, handles time cards and material records, and performs other office work as required. This employee

shall accrue classification seniority as and be paid the wage rate of a Roving Operator.

Since Mr. Jonas has held this classification since April 25, 1949, Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Jonas from Utilityman to Utility Roving Operator, effective August 1, 1961, without posting a vacancy in the latter job for bid.
