Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated February 21, 1955 with respect to the dual Utilityman-Gas Maker classification in the Gas Department at Eureka is hereby withdrawn.

Company has recently resurveyed the duties of such dual classification and proposes to reclassify this position, currently held by Mr. V. E. Kallio, to Utility Fitter at the wage rate of \$88.35 per week.

The proposed job definition for this classification is as follows:

Utility Fitter - Gas Department - Eureka

An employee who performs the duties of a Fitter in the Gas Transmission and Distribution Department and in addition may be required to perform such other duties as the preparation of gas holder reports; the calculation of data from orifice meter charts; the crating, shipping and receiving of gas meters; the testing, inventory and repair of gas meters and regulators; the operation of the gas distribution compressor; the spot painting of gas holders and industrial meter installations and the repair of tools.

This employee will accrue classification seniority as a Fitter.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one copy of this letter to Company.
