Gentlemen:

Company has recently completed a review of the operations at each of the Division load centers where Pressure Operators are employed. Since the wage rates of these classifications were last adjusted, responsibility for the following remote stations has been added to the duties of the Pressure Operators in Sacramento:

1. Serpa Junction Compressor Station
2. Rio Vista Wye - Meter & Regulator Station
3. Swingle Meter and Regulator Station
4. North Sacramento Mixing Station

Several other smaller additions to the responsibilities of these Pressure Operators have been made.

Due to the increased responsibilities of the Pressure Operators in Sacramento, Company proposes to modify the wage rate of this classification to the wage rate paid for Pressure Operators at San Francisco and Oakland. The proposed wage rate is as follows:

Start	\$ 125.90 per week
End 6 Mos.	\$ 129.65 per week
