Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 205.19 and 600.8 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to amend the lines of progression for the Water Systems Subforeman and Water Systems Repairman to include the Meteorological Instrumentman as a same or higher classification for purposes of Title 205 (see attachment).

We are currently in the process of filling a Meteorological Instrumentman position in Northern Area Hydro and the issue of a continuing line of progression has been raised by the bidders, all of whom are current Water Systems Repairman.

The purpose of this modification is to provide the Meteorological Instrumentman a return or advance line of progression.

The current job definition and lines of progression includes Water Systems Repairman as a next lower classification and states that they may be required to perform those duties.
