Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to establish a four-day, ten-hour schedule for the Angels Camp Transmission and Distribution employees. This specific agreement will be in accordance with the Generic Four-Day, Ten-Hour Agreement (86-155-PGE) except as listed below:

The present workweek consists of five eight-hour days from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The four-day, ten-hour schedule will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Tuesday through Friday.

AFFECTED EMPLOYEES

Subject to Union ratification, all employees in the Angels Camp Transmission and Distribution Department with the exception of Troublemens, will be assigned to this schedule.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This schedule will become effective the Tuesday following the Union's agreement to this schedule and run through October 28, 1990.

HOURS

Work hours will be from 0700 to 1730. Employees will receive a 1/2 hour unpaid lunch from 1200 to 1230.

CANCELLATION

Either the Company or Union reserves the right to return to the five-day, eight-hour schedule by giving a 15-day written notice.
