Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to modify the basic workweek for employees of the Computer Operations Department, Fairfield Computer Center.

When operations permit, and a Company holiday falls on a Monday, Company proposes to reschedule the basic workweek for those employees who are scheduled to work Saturdays and/or Sundays such that the employees would instead work on the Monday holiday and therefore have three consecutive days off.

In these instant cases, the Company would not pay any overtime for time worked on those holidays.

Company will also reschedule the basic workweek for those employees scheduled to work on Easter Sunday without the payment of overtime.
