## Gentlemen:

The following is a result of discussion held between the parties regarding the eligibility of certain classifications as participants in the Rubber Gloving Program.

In an effort to clarify LA 90-34 and its attachment defining the Implementation Procedures for Rubber Gloving which lists those classifications eligible to participate in the program, the parties agree that the intent in developing the list of eligible classifications was to include all overhead line classifications.

The original list of eligible classifications failed to include a Utility Lineman (1108) at Burney and a Utility Troubleman (2550) at Lincoln. Based on the above intent, the parties agree that these classifications should be added to the list of eligible classifications shown in Item 5 of the Implementation Procedures for Rubber Gloving. In addition, the parties agree that any employee entering an Underground Construction Crew classification from other than an overhead line classification would be excluded from participation in the Rubber Glove Program. This would, for example, exclude an employee in an Underground Construction Crew classification who enters the classification from Cable Splicer, which is not an overhead line classification.

Further, for future determination of eligibility for participation in the Rubber Glove program, the parties agree that based on this intent, any overhead line classification which is not listed under this agreement or currently in Item 5 of the Implementation Procedures for Rubber Gloving will be considered an eligible classification and will not require a separate agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
