Gentlemen:

The Company proposes pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Labor Agreement to establish the regular hours of work for the Telecommunication Technician position headquartered at 111 Stony Circle, Santa Rosa, and provide for a voluntary system of rotating assignments into this position.

The regular hours of work for this position will be 0700 to 1530 with one half hour for lunch. The Company will seek volunteers to temporarily fill the position from the Telecommunication Technicians headquartered at 3395 McMaude Place in Santa Rosa. The most senior volunteer will be given the assignment for six months at which point the Company will again seek volunteers for the next six months.

During the period of the assignment, 111 Stony Circle will be considered as the volunteer's regular headquarters as defined by Section 202.19 for purposes of Title 201. For all other Titles of the Agreement, 3395 McMaude Place will be considered as the volunteer's regular headquarters.


This Letter Agreement will benefit the employees in that the opportunity to work the "trouble hotline phone" at 111 Stony Circle may be rotated among the volunteering employees. Additionally, volunteers will not lose the opportunities which come from being headquartered at 3395 McMaude Place (i.e. overtime, upgrades, etc.)

This proposal has been discussed with Business Representative Larry Pierce. This agreement may be cancelled by either party by providing thirty days advance written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
