Gentlemen:

In reviewing the newly negotiated language of Section 111.16 of the Physical Labor Agreement and Section 8.16 of the Clerical Labor Agreement, the Company believes that the wording of the language fails to fully address the situations which the parties had intended to address.

In many situations where an employee's family member is experiencing a medical emergency, the employee experiences financial difficulties. Often times this is caused by the loss of income suffered when the employee's spouse stops work as a result of a major illness to himself/herself or to care for a child with a major illness. Taken literally, 111.16 and 8.16 would allow the transfer of vacation proceeds only if the employee has exhausted all paid leave.

To address the above situations, Company proposes to interpret Sections 111.16 and 8.16 as also applying to situations where employees are suffering financial hardship as a result of a medical emergency in their family even though they may have paid leave available. The language will continue to also apply as it literally reads. Local Agreement between Company and Union will continue to be required.
