Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement and Section 18.17 of the Clerical Agreement, the Company proposes to offer additional placement opportunities to up to 7 displaced employees in the Steam Generation Department due to the large number of vacancies throughout the Company and the desire to minimize the number of employee displacements. Company is specifically proposing:

- 1. In an attempt to reduce the list of displaced employees, the Company will offer employees in the same classification and headquarters as the employee subject to displacement an opportunity to take Severance Application II in accordance with Letter Agreement 93-42 and paragraph VII(B) of the Title 206 Clarification dated January 23, 1995. For the purposes of this provision of the agreement, Contra Costa and Pittsburg Power Plants will be considered as the same headquarters and the Geysers Power Plant will be considered one headquarters.
- 2. Displaced employees will receive Section 206.2 notification and a list of Title 206 options as well as a list of available entry-level physical and clerical vacancies. The list of vacancies will not include positions where there is a valid "a" bidder. Vacancy lists for displaced Electricians and Instrument Repairmen will also include Sr. Meterperson vacancies for provisional consideration.
- 3. Displaced employees will be given up to 12 workdays to prioritize and return their Title 206 option list. In lieu of prioritizing their Title 206 options, employees may decline their Title 206 rights and prioritize a list of available physical and clerical vacancies. Employees opting to prioritize available physical and clerical vacancies will be required to return their prioritized list of vacancies within the same 12 workday period given to prioritize Title 206 options.

- 4. Due to the large number of unfilled vacancies, the Company may continue to fill all clerical and physical vacancies included on the vacancy list during the 12 workdays employees are given to prioritize positions, however the Company will immediately cease to make job offers on the first seven prioritized vacancies when the employee returns their prioritization list (e.g. If an employee returns their prioritized list 2 workdays after receipt, the Company will cease making offers on the first 7 prioritized positions).
- 5. Employees who elect to forfeit their Title 206 rights and prioritize the list of vacancies, but do not have sufficient seniority to be awarded any of the vacancies prioritized, will be assigned layoff pursuant to Section 206.7
- 6. The application of this letter agreement is limited to the job assignments from the current wave of employee displacements.
- 7. Company and Union will make joint presentations to the employees impacted by this letter agreement prior to giving employees their Section 206.2 notification and list of displacement options.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
