An employee who possesses all the qualifications of a Meter Reader and shall be in direct charge of Meter Readers; he shall assign meter locations to routes and compile route books and make changes therein as advisable; he may perform the duties of a Meter Reader.

When in charge of 7 to 13 Meter Readers	\$36.90 per week
When in charge of 14 to 20 Meter Readers	\$39.00 per week
When in charge of 21 or more Meter Readers	\$45.30 per week.
