Gentlemen:

By letter agreement effective July 5, 1973, certain classifications were transferred between the IBEW and the ESC bargaining units, including the Gas Instrument Technician classification.

In regard to the Gas Instrument Technician classification, Company proposes the following, provisions of paragraph 1 of the July 5, 1973 agreement notwithstanding:

Employees currently classified as Gas Instrument Technician shall be reclassified to the Gas Measurement and Control Mechanic classification provided that such employee has successfully passed all schools provided for in the Apprentice Measurement and Control Mechanic training program. Any Gas Instrument Technician who has not passed the secondary and the tertiary schools shall be placed in the Orifice Meterman classification and red-circled at his present rate of pay until such time as the wage rate for the Orifice Meterman classification equals or exceeds his present wage rate. If and when he successfully completes the above training, he shall be reclassified to Measurement and Control Mechanic.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
