Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 3.5 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to waive the 30 minute automotive travel time requirement for Mr. Craig Sweeney, Troublemaker, headquartered in Chico, for the following reasons:

There are two Troublemakers headquartered in Paradise and five Troublemakers headquartered in Chico. The employees from these two headquarters share the same schedule and work the district as one service area.

Mr. Sweeney lives in Magalia which is just east of Paradise and about a 35 minute commute to his headquarters in Chico. This distance does not pose an operation problem.

This proposal has been discussed with Mickey Harrington, local Business Representative.
