Due to an increase in the service duties to be performed, Company is establishing a Troubleman classification, with headquarters at Hamilton Branch, and will eliminate the Senior Patrolman classification currently held by Mr. Harold Bredstrand. Since Mr. Bredstrand has performed the electric service work in this area for some time, Company proposes to reclassify him to Troubleman without posting the vacancy for bid. However, since Mr. Bredstrand has not completed his apprenticeship for the Lineman classification, he will not be considered qualified for a Line Subforeman vacancy unless he completes his apprenticeship.


