Gentlemen:

Company is planning to transfer effective no later than October 1, 1973 an Electrical Technician classification and a Communication Technician classification from Stockton to Tesla.

In an attempt to keep displacements under Title 206 of the Agreement to a minimum, employees in the appropriate classifications at Stockton were asked to volunteer for the move. As a result, two employees, Mr. J. W. Krause, Communications Technician and Mr. D. D. Davis, Electrical Technician, volunteered to be reassigned to Tesla. Since neither one of these employees is the junior employee, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 206.13 and 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to transfer these employees to the vacant positions at Tesla. Company further proposes that these individuals shall have the right to return to Stockton pursuant to Section 206.9 of the Physical Agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
