Gentlemen:

The Company and Union met to discuss the Open Enrollment process for 1998. The Open Enrollment process and health plan offerings will be the same as in 1997 with the following proposed exceptions:

• Currently, PG&E has contracts with nine HMOs, in addition to the Prudential plans. Beginning January 1, 1998, PG&E will have contracts with seven HMOs due to acquisitions that have occurred recently. HealthNet has acquired Foundation and PacifiCare has acquired FHP HealthCare. The HMOs that will be offered in 1998 are Aetna, HealthNet, Health Plan of the Redwoods, Kaiser North, Kaiser South, Lifeguard and PacifiCare. The PBGH model will be used as the plan design for PacifiCare (Attachment A). A three step approach will be used to notify current Foundation and FHP HealthCare members of this change. Two notification letters and a follow-up call will be placed to employees who are currently enrolled in the health plans that have been acquired to let them know that these plans are not viable choices for 1998. If another health plan is not selected during Open Enrollment, the employee and his/her dependents will be enrolled in the appropriate Prudential plan for calendar year 1998.

- HealthNet will be offered in all counties where it is available during the Open Enrollment period commencing October 1997, with an effective date of January 1, 1998
- Lifeguard will be offered in Nevada County during the Open Enrollment period commencing October 1997 with an effective date of January 1, 1998
- Beginning with the Open Enrollment period in 1998 with an effective date of January 1, 1999, Medicare Risk products will be offered in all counties where the companion health plans are offered (e.g. Secure Horizons is the Medicare Risk product for PacifiCare; if PacifiCare is offered in Alameda County, Secure Horizons will be offered in Alameda County as well)

The changes with an effective date of January 1, 1998, will be incorporated in the Open Enrollment materials that will be distributed this year.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
