Dear Mr. McNally:

The CPUC approved the process to sell Morro Bay Power Plant, Moss Landing Power Plant and Oakland Power Plant on September 3, 1997, thereby triggering the provisions of Letter Agreement 97-53.

As a result, the Company proposes to amend Letter Agreement 97-114-PGE/97-26-ESC to allow those Chemical Technologists at Moss Landing Power Plant and Morro Bay Power Plant to become eligible for the provisions outlined in Letter Agreement 97-53 effective September 3, 1997.
