Gentlemen:

Company is installing diesel power generating units at several locations on its system to provide emergency standby service. It is anticipated that it will be necessary to operate these plants for a few hours each week to insure their readiness for use in case of emergency.

To provide operators for these plants, Company proposes to revise the job description of Station Attendant as follows:

Station Attendant

A resident employee who resides at, and is in charge of, a hydro plant and performs all of the functions of a First Operator in the plant, and a Ditch Patrolman or Lake Tender on the related water systems. May be required to operate diesel power generating plants.
