Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 3.5 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to waive the 30-minute automotive travel time requirement for Messrs. Bonte and Brashear, Gas Servicemen at Clovis.

This waiver is predicated upon the fact that the above-mentioned Gas Servicemen's work schedules and overtime call-out procedures would not be a problem in terms of adequate rendition of service to the public. Additionally, only when the number of Gas Servicemen living within the 30-minute travel time is insufficient to meet a service need will Messrs. Bonte and Brashear be called out for emergency overtime.

This matter has been discussed with Frank Hutchins, Union Business Representative.
