Gentlemen:

The workload for the painters in the Plant Maintenance Group in Golden Gate Region is diminishing. Normally, these employees would be displaced and Title 206 of the Physical Agreement would be utilized for these employees.

However, due to an increasing workload in the Gas T&D Departments of Golden Gate Region resulting from the CPUC required painting workload, the Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 204.4(b) of the Physical Agreement, to amend the job classification of Painter as follows:

1927 PAINTER

An employee who is regularly engaged in painting inside or outside structures, valves, regulators, meters and associated piping, and who makes inspections and minor repairs to holders and other structures.

The affected painters and their new reporting headquarters are:
