Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 204.4(b) of the Physical Agreement, to have the Troublemens located in Placerville, El Dorado District, Drum Division, to perform emergency response gas work within El Dorado District.

Further, it is proposed that the Troublemens will respond to emergency calls of blowing gas and other emergencies such as gas leaks or odor of gas, fire or explosion, asphyxiation or carbon monoxide poisoning, high gas pressure and dig-ins of any nature. It is intended that when responding to blowing gas lines, they will only squeeze off 1/2" and 1" service lines, secure the area, and request gas crews for blowing mains. For the above situations other than blowing gas lines, it is intended that they will secure the area.

These employees will receive appropriate training and be proficient in handling procedures for shutting off gas facilities and squeezing off blowing gas lines, including proper reporting procedures.

This proposal has been reviewed with Union Business Representatives W. R. Greer and E. A. Fortier.
