Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, we propose to extend the trial 10-hour, 4-day workweek schedule for the Gas Service Department in Sacramento Division through June 25, 1988. The present trial period is scheduled to end December 26, 1987.

Our proposal, as outlined below, is consistent with the generic letter of agreement, except as noted.

## A. CLASSIFICATIONS

All bargaining unit personnel in the Sacramento Division Gas Service Department will participate, with the exception of the Service Operators and Relief Service Operators.

## B. WORKWEEK

Regular work hours will be 0700-1730 with personnel assigned as follows:

Fourteen (14) Servicemen will be assigned Monday through Thursday.  
 Ten (10) Servicemen will be assigned Tuesday through Friday.  
 Twenty (20) Servicemen will be assigned Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday with Wednesdays off.  
 Ten (10) Servicemen will be assigned Wednesday through Saturday.  
 Four (4) Servicemen will be assigned Sunday through Wednesday.  
 Five (5) Reserve Servicemen will be assigned Monday through Thursday.  
 Five (5) Reserve Servicemen will be assigned Tuesday through Friday.

## C. MEALS AND BREAKS

Lunch period will normally be five hours after start time. However, the regular lunch period may be advanced or delayed up to one-half hour for any of the reasons listed in Section 202.4 of the Agreement.

Two coffee breaks not to exceed fifteen minutes will be permitted; breaks are to be taken mid-morning and mid-afternoon. Lunch periods and breaks cannot be accumulated or combined and taken together.

D. HOLIDAYS

Holidays - Ten hours pay will be paid for holidays. Employees regularly scheduled to work on holidays will only work eight hours and receive ten hours holiday pay (straight time) and eight hours pay at time and a half rate. The provisions of Section 103.6 shall apply to holidays on an employee's non-workday (utilizing the ten-hour credit as applied in Item No. 2 above).

E. CANCELLATION CLAUSE

This Agreement may be cancelled 30 days after receipt of written notice of such cancellation by either party. In such a case, all employees would return to their regular eight hour shifts in effect on December 31, 1986.

This proposal has been discussed with Mr. Wayne Greer, Union Business Representative.
