Dear Mr. McNally:

PG&E is proposing to read water meters in the City of Gonzales under a pilot program for a period of 6 months, beginning in September or October, 1999.

Currently, there are 4 full routes and 1 partial route to read gas and electric meters in Gonzales. During this pilot, water meters will be added to each route. Meter Readers will enter the water meter readings into a separate EMR device.


The pilot is expected to result in minimal overtime. All overtime assignments will be voluntary.

This proposal has been discussed with Business Representative Ed Caruso.
