Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to establish a Utilityman position at Kettleman Compressor Station. The attendant job description and proposed wage schedule is as follows:

2570 Utilityman (Kettleman)

An employee who performs general maintenance and repair work on buildings, furniture, plumbing, wiring, tools, and equipment, etc. May also be required to perform the duties of a Cook's Helper.

Start	- \$428.50
End 6 Months	- \$433.30
End 1 Year	- \$446.70

Company further proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Curtis L. Talley (Cook's Helper at Helms) into such newly created position. The classification will be next lower to Maintenance man (1160) in the line of progression. In addition, the employees listed in Company's letter of November 4, 1981, will have Title 206 rights to re-employment.
