Pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) and Section 202.22 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to temporarily assign operating employees from Avon, Martinez and Oleum Power Plants to the Moss Landing Power Plant.

This action is necessary due to an anticipated demand for electricity which will require the operation of Units 1-3 at Moss Landing Power Plant during the months of May through September.

Meals and incidental expenses would be paid by the Company in the same manner as they are for Steam Generation Traveling Maintenance Crews.
