The above-subject grievance has been reviewed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division for further investigation. Before the Review Committee will accept the grievance, the following information is needed:

The record does not indicate when the work assignments of the Reserve Gas Servicemen to the Gas Meter Shop took place and for what duration. This information is necessary to the Review Committee in determining if the grievance was timely filed. Additionally, there is no explanation as to what circumstances were present that necessitated the Reserve Gas Servicemen to be assigned to the Gas Meter Shop.

After the investigation is completed, the Committee should again attempt to resolve the grievance. If the unresolved issue becomes one of working Reserve Gas Serviceman in another Line of Progression, it is the opinion of the Review Committee that when the Reserve Gas Servicemen classification was negotiated, it was the intent of the parties that this classification would normally be used in the Gas T&D Line of Progression. However, if circumstances justify a definite need for the classification to work in other Lines of Progression, then it would be proper.

If the Committee cannot resolve the grievance, then the case should be returned to the Review Committee accompanied by a joint report of your findings.
