

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division for settlement in accordance with the following:

In reviewing the record submitted to the Review Committee, procedural questions as well as informational ones arose, which necessitated the Pre-Review Committee to meet locally with members of the North Bay Local Investigating Committee. It was determined that there was a first-level discussion held on May 15, 1975 with an exempt supervisor in attendance. Therefore, the grievance procedure has been adhered to and the referral is properly before the Pre-Review Committee. Secondly and most important, it was determined that the issue of PG&E electric crews, in Santa Rosa District, working on Pacific Telephone and Telegraph equipment has been resolved locally, and if that is the case, the Pre-Review is of the opinion that the Joint Grievance Committee should close the case without adjustment and so note the disposition in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.

When a settlement is reached by the Joint Grievance Committee, the Review Committee should be sent a copy of the final disposition.
