



The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

This case concerns an alleged violation of Section 24.5 of the Clerical Agreement. On June 11, 1982, a Utility Clerk-Operating at the Edenvale Service Center resigned. On April 15, 1983, Union filed a grievance stating that the Company had utilized four different agency employees on a consecutive basis to perform the work previously performed by the former Utility Clerk-Operating. The correction requested was that the Company fill the Utility Clerk vacancy. On June 20, 1983, this vacancy was filled. However, in the interim, on May 1, 1983, a second Utility Clerk position was vacated and an agency employee continued in the Department. This second vacancy was filled on October 17, 1983 and since October 21, 1983, there have been no temporary agency employees in the Administrative Services Department at Edenvale.

Based on the foregoing, the Pre-Review Committee agrees that the issue is moot and closes this case without adjustment and without prejudice to the position of either party. Such closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
