
The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

This case concerns the proper rate of pay for travel time home in conjunction with a prearranged overtime assignment. The grievants worked twelve hours on a prearranged assignment at the time and one-half rate. They were paid one-half hour travel time in each direction. The correction asked for is to pay one hour of travel time at the double-time rate.

This question is not new to the grievance procedure and has been settled before although under situations arising from the application of Section 208.2(c). Travel time is not considered time worked for the purposes of determining double-time entitlement under Section 208.2(b). If the employees had worked in excess of twelve consecutive hours and were paid at the double-time rate for work performed, then they would have also been entitled to the double-time rate for travel time home.

The Committee agreed that there was no contractual violation and closes this case without adjustment and without prejudice to the Company's position in Pre-Review Committee Case No. 886. Such closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
