The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step 5A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

On April 1, 1985 an Electric Meter Crew Foreman, Fresno, retired. The vacancy was filled through temporary upgrade because of reorganization plans. The Union grieved on June 27, 1986 requesting the vacancy be filled on a permanent basis. Company declined citing Pre-Review Committee No. 720.

Since this case has been on the agenda of the Pre-Review Committee, the decision has been made to relocate the Electric Meter Shop from Fresno to Oakland thereby making the grievance issue moot.

The parties agree to close this case without adjustment and without prejudice to the position of the parties based on the relocation of the Shop.
