Subject of the Grievance:


This case concerns the use of hand held computers by Transmission Troublemens to input data gathered from transmission line patrols. In the past, the Transmission Troublemens documented their findings with pencil and paper. The information was then given to a clerk for input into a computer database for tracking patrols and repairs. The hand held computers are given to a clerk who then downloads the information into the database.

Discussion:

The Pre-Review Committee finds there is no violation of the Agreement. The work performed by both the Transmission Troublemens and the clerk are the same except for the technological upgrading of the means to accomplish the work.

Decision:

This case is closed without adjustment.
