This case concerns whether or not Title 206 was violated when the Company allegedly failed to list a Garberville Utility Clerk/Meter Reader vacancy as an option.

Discussion and Disposition

The dispute in this case centers around whether a Utility Clerk/Meter Reader vacancy should have been included as an option during a wave of displacement. The Company's position was that the vacancy had not been approved for filling at the time the displacements took place.

The Title 206 Committee noted that the vacancy was utilized as an option in a subsequent wave of displacement and was assigned to a displaced employee. Given that the vacancy was used as an option and was assigned under Title 206, the Committee agreed to close this case.

The Committee agrees to close the case on the above basis.
