These cases involve company's use of contractors by Hydro Construction while there were qualified laid-off employees in the rehire pool. The issues raised in these cases, the grievants, the time frame, and the department appear to be the same as in Review Committee File No. 1777 which was settled with adjustment March 23, 1995.

These cases are being returned to the LIC to resolve in accordance with RC 1777. If the time frame that the contractor was performing work is the same as in RC 1777, the cases should be settled without further adjustment, inasmuch as the required adjustment has already been granted by settlement of this earlier case. If the time frame is different than in RC 1777, then some adjustment may be in order.

The LIC is requested to confirm by memo to the Pre-Review Committee the outcome of its findings.

These cases are considered closed based on the foregoing, however, the PRC retains jurisdiction should the LIC not be able to resolve the issues.
