Subject of the Grievance

This grievance alleges "Company is using non-union contractors without paying prevailing wage in violation of the agreement."

Facts of the Case

In April 2000 Company executed a contract with ICU Contractor Engineers for a turnkey project at the Kettleman Compressor Station. Kaiser sub-contracted with CECO for Electricians to install conduit, pull some wire, and complete half of the terminations. Title 300, General Construction employees completed the other half.

Certain provisions of Exhibit XVI became effective on July 1, 2000 and others by December 31, 2000. Both dates are after the letting of the Kaiser contract and therefore Company cannot be in violation of prevailing wage or union friendly provisions of Exhibit XVI as those provisions had not yet become effective.

Decision

No violation of the Agreement occurred. This case is closed without adjustment.
