Subject of the Grievance

This case concerns the temporary assignment of various Operating Clerks to perform work in Santa Rosa.

## Facts of the Case

Over an extended period of time, three separate supervisors were sending three different Operating Clerks from various locations to perform work in Santa Rosa for up to a combined total of five days per week. This was not a coordinated effort, nor was each of the supervisors aware of the others' assignments. There was no vacancy or vacated position.

Subsequent to the filing of this grievance, Company authorized the filling of a new Operating Clerk-Typist in Santa Rosa. This vacancy (JV# 021153) was posted on the September 6, 2002 Job Awards Bulletin as No Qualified Bidders. It was filled pursuant to 18.13 by an external hire.

## **Discussion**

Union opined Company is obligated to upgrade from a next lower classification into a temporary vacancy rather than assign an employee in the same classification from another headquarters.

Company responded that there is nothing in the labor agreement that precludes a lateral temporary assignment. Furthermore, the Fact Finding Committee determined that there was only one Utility Clerk in the headquarters, and that employee was already upgraded to Service Representative. Finally, assuming there was an employee in the headquarters who wanted the upgrade, that person either did not have a bid on file or declined the job opportunity during the filling of JV #011153.

## Decision

No violation of the agreement occurred. This case is closed without adjustment.
