Subject of the Grievance

This case concerns the pick-up of hazardous waste from the Concord and Antioch Service Centers by a contractor, Phillips Transportation and Remediation (PTR).

Facts of the Case

PTR visits each service center every three months to collect hazardous material and had been doing so for over three years prior to the filing of the grievance. In addition, contractor employees visit the Concord, Walnut Creek and Antioch yards once a week to label hazardous containers and make a record of the hazardous inventory. The contractor employee assists the grievant with packaging transformers to be sent to Emeryville and to move hazardous waste drums. Weekly, the contractor spends approximately six hours in Concord; one hour in Walnut Creek; and six hours in Antioch.

Discussion

This issue has previously been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee and resolved by PRC 14674 on the basis that the work is incidental within the meaning of Item 4, General Provisions of Exhibit XVI and the reporting of the contractor's hours by the General Services Department.

Decision

This case is closed without adjustment on the basis of PRC 14674.
