
Dear Mr. Mitchell:

The Company members of the Review Committee are in accord with Union's proposal to drop the grievance which is the subject of R. C. File 25 without prejudice.

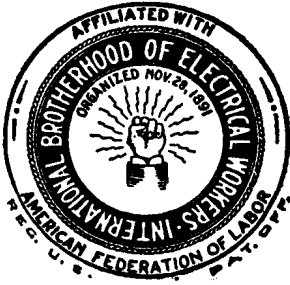
The Committee shall, therefore, consider this case closed, and a memorandum to that effect will be placed in the file.

Dear Mr. Thompson:

The Union's Committee members are of the opinion that the subject of R.C. File #25 is properly that of the equal distribution of overtime and that the answer to the original grievance as contained in the minutes of the San Joaquin Division Grievance Committee of December 3, 1952 and January 7, 1953 covers the issue and it should have been closed.

The "submission of facts" in this case goes beyond the scope of the subject of the original grievance and raises other issues which we feel are not covered by Section 208.16. Therefore, we suggest that the case be dropped without prejudice.
