Dear Mr. Thompson:

Relative to our discussion of Review Committee
File No. 36. The Union's Committee feels that the Company representative at Davis was derelict in his duties
and took the easy way out to avoid embayrassment to himself. We do not feel that the employees should be used
to save the boss from shouldering his responsibilities.

We further feel that the efficiency and harmony spoken of in the contract was harmed with this type of action, and hope that steps will be take to eliminate a recurrence of the same. We feel that pursuing this grievance would tend to add to this disharmony and in view of the additional information presented by the Company we propose to withdraw the grievance from the Review Committee.
